



# Get the quality care you deserve with our Community Health Access Program

The Kaiser Permanente Community Health Access Program is designed to provide health care coverage to low income individuals and families who do not have access to any other public or private health coverage programs.

The program offers financial help to pay for a Kaiser Permanente Individuals and Families (KPIF) MD Gold 0/20 or VA Gold 0/20 plan. For eligible applicants, there will be a \$0 monthly premium and \$0 copay for most services received at Kaiser Permanente medical centers for up to 24 months.

## TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE COMMUNITY HEALTH ACCESS PROGRAM, APPLICANTS MUST:

- Live within the Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of the Mid-Atlantic States, Inc., service area
- Live in a household with incomes up to 300% of the Federal Poverty Level (see chart to the right)
- Not have access to any other public or private health care coverage including, but not limited to:
  - Maryland HealthChoice
  - Virginia Medicaid/FAMIS
  - Medicare
  - Coverage through Maryland Health Connection or the Health Insurance Marketplace in Virginia
  - Job-based coverage

Applicants must complete an Application for Health Coverage for the KPIF MD or VA Gold 0/20 plan and a Kaiser Permanente Subsidy Eligibility Form and submit them together with proof of income (such as recent pay stubs, W-2 forms, or wage and/or tax statements).
